Many scientific researches proved that the captive population of older nulliparous has increased and is facing the reproductive pathological lesions which led to the failure of the breeding programme.

From our knowledge we can conclude that we should "Breed female elephant as fast as we can (in puberty period) to prevent reproductive problems in the future!"
